

The Families of Consciousness: Their Colors and The Key Traits Underpinning Their Creative Intent

The articulation of “**intent**” (the directional force within and part of Consciousness) through the human psyche loosely conforms to nine distinguishable forms of expression. Essentially, they are differing developmental paths of activity peculiar to humankind, involved with the growth, learning and evolution of each individual and humanity itself.

Although your personality encapsulates all of the intentional forces of the Families of Consciousness, it chooses to experience the physical dimension with certain expressions of intent to the fore during its lifetime’s learning.

A deep understanding of this material is required before attempting to use it in the help of others. This is a precaution that will hopefully prevent the information from being co-opted into yet another distorted belief system in respect of personality profiling.

At heart, the Families of human intent provide a fluid, yet significant guide to the subtleties of intent expressed through human consciousness. As such, and in view of a person's allegiance to the expressions of certain families rather than others, they give indication as to a person's personal motivations, and thereby, a clue as to the general purpose of their current lifetime.

This is NOT a hierarchical structuring within the human psyche. No one Family is “better” to be aligned with than another. Each helps to form a piece of the puzzle of human personality.

 **SUMARI** (Artists/Speakers) Most strongly associated color: **BLUE**
Key Traits: A drive to change the status quo. Loves to explore the aesthetics of physical expressions. Encourages acts of change through the language of art. Colloquially named the ‘doers’ in society. Extroverts with a keen use of humor. They are independent and nonconformist, enjoy the spotlight, and find fulfilment across the breadth of the arts.

 **ILDA** (Exchangers/Informers) Most strongly associated color: **GREEN**
Key Traits: A drive to communicate and exchange information and knowledge. Loves to spread ideas and concepts across differing cultures. Able to see the bigger picture and form connections. Enjoys traveling and trading. They are colorful characters, extremely vocal, and keen to use humor to ease communication between contrasting belief systems.

 **TUMOLD** (Healers/Readers) Most strongly associated color: **INDIGO**
Key Traits: A Family that focuses upon helping others and healing—both individual and cultural healing. They heal from a spiritual perspective, adept at reading and channeling energies to assist a return to well-being. They are adept at societal and planetary healing and are keen to promote self-healing.

-  **ZULI** (Imagers) Most strongly associated color: **VIOLET**
Key Traits: Primarily focused on the expression of the human form in the physical domain. But also, the design of other living forms and all physical structures. Dedicated to perfecting beauty, elegance, and performance. They have inspired design capabilities and enjoy being involved in a broad spectrum of artistic design.
-  **GRAMADA** (Innovators/Formers) Most strongly associated color: **ORANGE**
Key Traits: Involved with creating, initiating, inventing, and innovating. Tend not to take the spotlight. Particularly adept at inventing physical objects as well as efficient systems for the benefit of society in general. They are truly inspired, able to connect concepts forming worldviews at the Essence level of our consciousness.
-  **BORLEDIM** (Nurturers/Bearers) Most strongly associated color: **PINK**
Key Traits: A Family of intent concerned with nurturing. They demonstrate great affection, patience, fairness, and understanding—guiding without being pushy. Spiritually nurturing all living things, not just our children. They are family oriented, with excellent parenting skills.
-  **VOLD** (Reformers/Hearers) Most strongly associated color: **YELLOW**
Key Traits: A Family that likes to reform through revolution. They activate reform at all levels, from personal belief systems to collective belief systems reflected in world institutions—political, religious, financial, and educational—to family values and societal mores. Restless, passionate, and attuned to their emotions.
-  **MILUMET** (Spiritualistic/Rememberers) Most strongly associated color: **RED**
Key Traits: This Family emphasizes the spiritual nature of everything in existence and is very much concerned with keeping us aware of the natural rhythms and cycles of life, such as “natural time.” This Family nourishes the collective psyche of humanity—reminding us of our own divinity.
-  **SUMAFI** (Teachers/Seers) Most strongly associated color: **BLACK**
Key Traits: Closely involved with the act of teaching, the relaying of knowledge in its purest form. They promote learning through experience and when conveying information, they maintain a concern for accuracy, detail, and integrity in the information transfer. Can be seen as pedantic.
